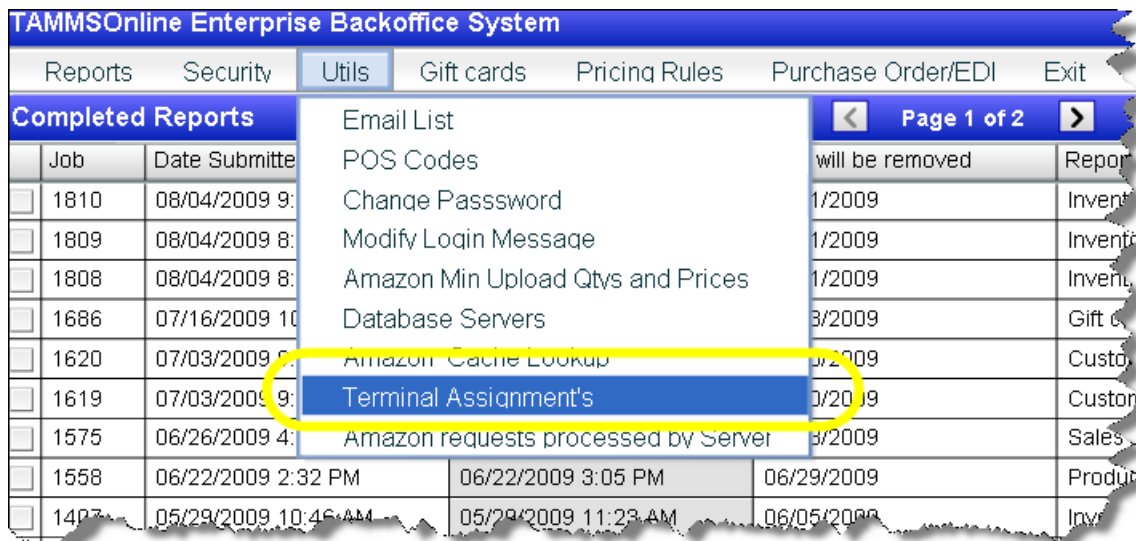

Title: Assigning a computer MAC Address to a TAMMS Station number

This module allows you assign your own MAC addresses to a station number or re-assign your numbers. To perform this task you will need to access the Back Office System.

Once in the Back Office System select the Terminal Assignments option under the UTIL menu.



Once in the module you will see at the bottom of your screen a Serial Number drop down field. Select the serial number of the store you want to modify and press the Refresh List button.




This will give you a list of all your existing terminals assigned to this store and their MAC addresses.

The two areas you can modify are the MAC Address and the Assigned To field. The Assigned to field is what is used to show up in the TAMMS Terminal Window and the MAC Address is the MAC address of a active NIC (network interface card) adapter in a computer. If this is a laptop that is used for wired and wireless then you can select ether NIC MAC Address as long as the card is never disabled. The system will look and use all active NIC Cards.

You can also assign the same MAC address to more than one register if you need to open more than one register on the same computer.

Also if you need to do a remote close of a register you can modify the mac address of the register you need to close to your mac address, get into tamms terminal select that store and register, do the close, then go back and restore the old mac address to the register. Make sure you copy the old mac address to your notepad prior to doing this are you might not remember it when you go back to reset this.

Note that the TAMMS Terminal only see's these changes when it starts up. So you will need to exit out of TAMMS terminal and back in to see the changes on the stations.
